Emergency Medical Technician-Basic, Adv. EMT

How To Apply:

1. Submit an application at www.westerntc.edu/apply. Choose “Enroll in a Program” and select the Adv. EMT or EMT-Basic program which is found under the “Law, Public Safety, Corrections and Security” cluster area on the application. Choose “EMT Basic full program” or “Adv. EMT” (\$30)
2. Complete a [background check](#) via ViewPoint Screening (\$48)
3. Read, Sign and Return the following forms to admissions@westerntc.edu

4. Complete 2Step TB Testing with your healthcare provider

EMR to EMT Part 1 , Critical Care Transport - Paramedic

How To Apply:

1. Submit an application at www.westerntc.edu/apply. Choose “Just take a course or two” and indicate you are interested in the EMR to EMT Part 1, or Critical Care Transport course.

Emergency Medical Technician-Basic Part 2:

A current WI Emergency Medical Responder certification is required. This course builds upon the EMR course. Once completed, candidates will be eligible to participate in the National Registry of EMT Exam.
